

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NORFOLK ROAD, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along NORFOLK ROAD, WEYMOUTH between its junctions with Somerset Road and Sussex Road, a distance of approximately 125 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 13 February 2023 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17 February 2023.

This Notice will enable Jurassic Fibre Limited safe access to lay duct in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Sussex Road - Queensland Road - Corporation Road - Chickerell Road - Quibo Lane - Norfolk Road
