TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, DORCHESTER ROAD, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

The Notice comes in to operation on 5 February 2024 between 0930 and 1530 and will remain in force for 5 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9 February 2024.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out essential highway maintenance works.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

[1] To impose temporary clearway on Dorchester Road between its junctions with Springrove Court and Spa Road to prevent vehicles from stopping except those associated with the works.

Please note that any vehicle waiting in contravention of temporary parking restrictions may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986. If a vehicle has been removed, the owner must contact the Council's vehicle recovery contractor: Ashleywood Recovery Ltd/Bride Valley Recovery Ltd on 01305 889421.
