

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ENKWORTH ROAD, PRESTON

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along ENKWORTH ROAD, PRESTON at its southern end from its junction with Oakbury Drive, a distance of 35 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 1 April 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5 May 2024.

This Order will enable Wessex Water to replace water main.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Oakbury Drive - Enkworth Road
