

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, NORTH QUAY, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

The Order comes in to operation on 14 March 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months.

This Order will enable Dorset Council, safe access to carry out emergency works to the harbour wall.

The effect of the Order is as follows:

[1] To impose temporary eastbound lane closure on North Quay for the extent of the bus lane on the westbound lane, to provide safe working area.

Please be advised that all westbound traffic will utilise the bus lane.
