

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE ESPLANADE (SOUTHBOUND), WEYMOUTH FOR ANZAC PARADE 2024

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Thursday 25 April 2024 between 10:30 and 11:45, the following restrictions will be imposed;

- [1] To impose temporary road closure, southbound on The Esplanade between Lennox Street and Astrid Way
- [2] To impose temporary temporary clearway for the extent of parking bays outside Pier Bandstand as indicated by signs on site

The alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Lennox Street, Victoria Street and Astrid Way. Traffic management officers will be stationed at either end of the closure to facilitate local public buses on service through the closure and maintain access to Brunswick Terrace.
