

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF VARIOUS ROADS, WEYMOUTH FOR FAYRE IN THE SQUARE 2024

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Saturday 25 May 2024 until 26 May 2024 between 08:00 and 18:00, the following restrictions will be imposed;

- [1] To impose temporary road closure on Trinity Road from its junction with North Quay to its junction with Cove Street
- [2] To impose temporary road closure on Cove Street from its junction with Trinity Road to its junction with Hope Street
- [3] To revoke the one way system on Spring Road between its junctions with Horsford Street and Hope Street to allow temporary two way access for residents only
- [4] To suspend parking at Cove Street, Cove Row, Trinity Road and Hope Square as indicated by signs on site. Permit holders in Zone L will be permitted to park in Nothe Car Park and North Quay (Council Offices) car park at no extra charge between 20:00 Friday 24 May and 18:00 Sunday 26 May 2024.
