

TEMPORARY PARKING SUSPENSIONS ON TRINITY ROAD/COVE ROW, WEYMOUTH, FOR WESSEX FOLK FESTIVAL 2024

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following parking bays by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Friday 31 May 2024 until Monday 3 June 2024 between 12:00 and 12:00 or as indicated by signs on site

The effect of this Order will be:

[1] To impose temporary parking suspension on Trinity Road parking bays at sand jetty between Friday 31 May 2024 until Monday 3 June 2024 between 12:00 and 12:00

[2] To impose temporary parking suspension on the remainder of Trinity Road and all of Cove Row from 2000hrs on Friday 31 May 2024 until 2000hrs on Sunday 2 June 2024

Zone L permit holders will be permitted to park in the Nothe Car Park or the Council Offices car park on North Quay at no extra charge between 0600hrs on Saturday 1 June 2024 until 2000hrs on Sunday 2 June 2024
