

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SPA ROAD, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Spa Road, Weymouth from its junction with Dorchester Road to its junction with Kings Road, a distance of approximately 110 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 7 October 2024 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 October 2024.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out essential highway maintenance works.

Please note that the dates are a window of opportunity and the road may not be closed for the whole duration stated above and the works are weather dependant. A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
