

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF (PART OF) THE ESPLANADE AND CUSTOM HOUSE QUAY, WEYMOUTH FOR WEYMOUTH BEACH MOTOCROSS 2024

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Sunday 20 October 2024 between 08:00 and 17:00.

The effect of this notice is as follows:

- [1] To impose temporary road closure on The Esplanade between its junction with Devonshire Buildings and the mini roundabout in front of the Pavillion Car Park
- [2] To impose temporary road closure on the section of The Esplanade which fronts the Pavillion forecourt leading to Custom House Quay

The road fronting Devonshire Buildings will be open for access only.

Traffic will be re-routed through the one-way system around Alexandra Gardens to continue on The Esplanade, or can use South Parade for access to Custom House Quay.
