

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KING STREET, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along KING STREET, WEYMOUTH between its junctions with Crescent Street and Queen Street, a distance of approximately 50 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 4 November 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 November 2024.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out urgent works to repair collapsed sewer in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: King Street - B3155 - A354 - B3159 - B3155
