

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MILL STREET, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along MILL STREET, WEYMOUTH between its junctions with Dorchester Road and Watery Lane, a distance of 125 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 21 November 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24 April 2025.

This Order will enable Chevron Traffic Management on behalf of CG Fry to carry out building works to the Church.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Watery Lane - Stottingway Street - Dorchester Road
