

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WEYMOUTH ROAD, MARTINSTOWN

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along WEYMOUTH ROAD, MARTINSTOWN between its junction with the C53 and Turnpike Cottage, a distance of approximately 135 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 18 November 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 19 November 2024.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out works associated with a flood prevention scheme in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3159 - A35 - A354 - Icen Lane - Dorchester Road - Elwell Street - B3159
