

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF QUEEN STREET, WEYMOUTH - NIGHT CLOSURE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along QUEEN STREET, WEYMOUTH between its junction with the railway station and its junction with Ranelagh Road, a distance of approximately 20 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation at 1900hrs on 16 December 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 0600hrs on 17 December 2024.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to underground structures in the carriageway to carry out civils works of two blockage clearance along with excavation.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Ranelagh Road - Chelmsford Street - Hardwick Street - Astrid Way - B3155 - King Street
