

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DORCHESTER ROAD, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along DORCHESTER ROAD, WEYMOUTH between 295 Dorchester Road and 283A Dorchester Road, a distance of approximately 45 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation at 0800 on 12 January 2025 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1800 on 12 January 2025.

This Notice will enable Chevron Traffic Management safe access to facilitate a crane lift in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Dorchester Road - The Esplanade - King Street - A354
