

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, MITCHELL STREET, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

The Order comes in to operation on 20 January 2025 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 July 2025.

This Order will enable Woodmace safe access to facilitate multiple crane lifts and concrete pumping associated with the regeneration of the Old Methodist Chapel.

The effect of the Order is as follows:

- [1] To impose temporary road closure on Mitchell Street for its entirety. Please note that the road will only be closed at such times when indicated by signs on site, it will not be closed for the entire duration.
- [2] To revoke the one way system on Mitchell Street between no. 4 and its junction with East Street
- [3] To impose temporary two-way traffic flow on Mitchell Street between no. 4 and its junction with East Street for residents and business access during the closure periods

An alternative route will be signed using: Maiden Street - Bond Street - The Esplanade - Custom House Quay
