DORSET COUNCIL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SCHEME, VARIOUS ROADS, WEYMOUTH

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of Dorset proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The general effect of the Order will be to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions along parts of the A354 Portland Road and Merley Road, Weymouth.

As part of the traffic management scheme, Dorset Council in exercise of powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to:

- Install a new signalised puffin crossing along the A354 Portland Road, Weymouth
- Install a new signalised toucan crossing along Langton Avenue, Weymouth (at its junction with the A354 Portland Road)
- Install a new signalised puffin crossing along Merley Road, Weymouth (at its junction with the A354 Portland Road).
