

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLOUCESTER MEWS, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along GLOUCESTER MEWS, WEYMOUTH between Royal Yard car park and its junction with Gloucester Street, a distance of approximately 75 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 11 February 2025 between 0930 and 1330 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 February 2025.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out defect works in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Gloucester Mews - King Street - Commercial Road - Wooperton Street - Park Street - Gloucester Street
