

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WEYMOUTH BAY AVENUE, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along WEYMOUTH BAY AVENUE, WEYMOUTH from its junction with Dorchester Road to no. 7, a distance of approximately 65 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 16 April 2025 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 April 2025.

This Notice will enable SGN safe access to carry out remedial works in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Dorchester Road - Monmouth Avenue - Cleveland Avenue
